NEW RAMP NOW OPEN TO TRAFFIC! As of **10:50 a.m. TODAY, Friday, November 21**, the new eastbound I-70 to K-7 ramp is **NOW OPEN** to unrestricted traffic in Bonner Springs (Wyandotte County). Crews are finishing up traffic control work this afternoon and evening and will fully open the ramp to traffic after rush hour tomorrow morning. This ramp work is part of the K-7 & I-70 Interchange Project Phase 1 construction.
