Westbound I-70 at K-7 Interchange

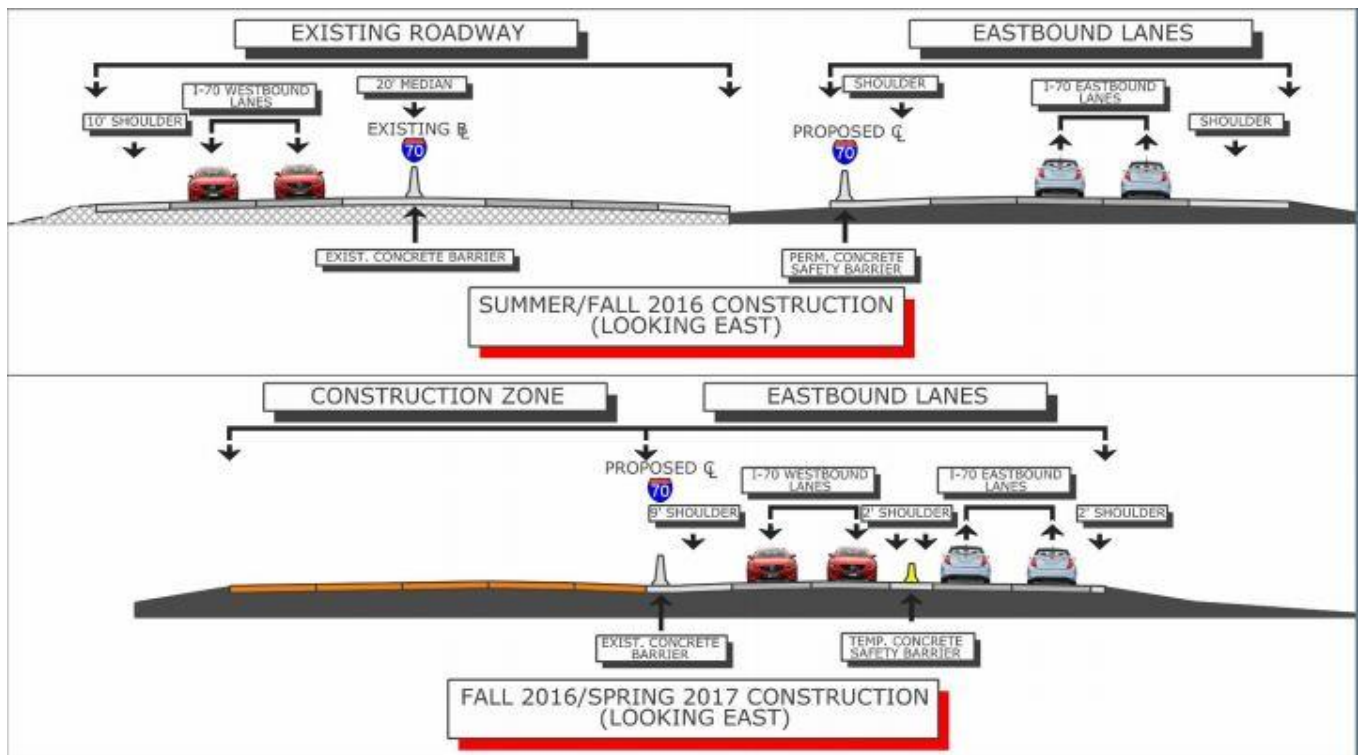
NOW OPEN! Westbound I-70 between the K-7 interchange entrance and exits ramp (see map above) is **NOW OPEN to TWO FULL LANES of traffic** as of **11:50 a.m., TODAY, Monday, November 14**. Crossover construction work has been completed early and the roadway has been reopened to two full lanes of traffic.
